



In the past week the class has turned into a bunch of non-stopped talkers. It is becoming a struggle to get through all of our daily lessons due to A LOT of talking during lessons and transitions. Last week we practiced a "Yacker Tracker" strategy. I am hoping to reduce the amount of talking in our classroom.

Each day will start with everyone having 5 cubes. When a student talks out, they will lose one cube. If the student loses 3 cubes, they have to write a goal for the next day and take it home to be signed. If a student loses 3 or more points they will need to write a note home explaining why they lost all of their cubes and what their goal for the next day may be.

I will also reward students for keeping all of their cubes each day. I am hoping that this will reduce the amount of talking considerably. You will be updated daily about your second grader's progress. There will be a "Yacker Tracker" glued in your second graders agenda weekly. This will show you how your second grader does each day.
